PRINCIPAL'S REPORT



Welcome back for the 2024 School Year. I hope you have all had a wonderful summer break, and you have had the chance to recharge and refresh after what was a very challenging 2023. We are so looking forward to the year ahead and it was awesome seeing all the children coming in the gate with smiles on their faces this morning. We welcomed our new students and families with a Mihi Whakatau and I know they will find our school and community a great place to be!

High Expectations: The start of a new year is the perfect time to re-set our high expectations for our students including their academic, social, and personal development. We want every child to experience success. This can look different for each child, but our focus is on every child aiming high and giving everything their best shot. This is expected both inside and outside the classroom and is often reflected in how they interact and speak with their peers and teachers. We make no apology for calling out and dealing with behaviour that does not meet our high expectations as a school.

As a team we aim to build positive relationships with all our students and recognise that we do this by knowing them well. A key ingredient to the success of this relationship is the connection you have with the school and teacher. You know your child best and if there is something you think the teacher should know please pass it on. If there is something you are unsure of with your child and their learning, please ask. Don't let a small problem become a bigger one by letting things drag on.





Swimming and Water Safety: The school pool is open, and the students will be swimming this term. All classes have at least three swimming sessions each week. Please send your child to school with togs and a towel everyday as sometimes they can squeeze in an extra swim. Developing their water confidence and skills is an essential life-saving skill that is so important in a country like ours. It is also a part of our NZ School Curriculum. Given the importance of this and the fact we don't want any child to miss out we have developed a variety of dry water skill knowledge activities for children to complete who forget their togs.

Reading: There is a very strong correlation between the children who spend 20 minutes a night reading with their parents/caregivers and those that experience success in reading. This can be reading with or reading to your child. It makes a significant difference, so if you can do one thing with your child, please read. They are worth it!

Eskdale School Teaching Team and Support Staff: The 2024 teaching team are looking forward to the year ahead. If you need to touch base with the teacher the most effective way of getting in touch during the school day is generally via email. If you have a concern or worry the teacher should always be the first port of call and if this doesn't resolve the issue, please reach out to Mike Moriarty who is the Deputy Principal for the Junior School or Tineke Hill who is Deputy Principal for the Senior School.

School Fees/Donations: We have been able to keep our school fees/donations the same again for the third year running. Our 2024 school fees/donations are set at \$40.00 per term. These form an integral part of ensuring we can provide all the resources we want to for our students. The funds provided by the Ministry of Education do not cover all of the resources we believe are essential for every child to experience success. Over the past 12 months we have used the school donations for increased teachers in classes (reducing teacher to student ratio), increased literacy support time, increased teacher aide support and purchased additional learning resources.


2024 Recommended School Fee/Donation: \$40.00 per term or
